"I Am Alive in You" Message #10 in the series "Who Do You Say That I Am?" John 7:37-44

³⁷ On the last day of the festival, the great day, while Jesus was standing there, he <u>cried out</u>, "Let anyone who is thirsty come to me, ³⁸ and let the one who believes in me drink. As the scripture has said, '<u>Out of the believer's heart shall flow rivers of living</u> <u>water</u>." ³⁹ Now he said this about the Spirit, which believers in him were to receive; for as yet there was no Spirit, because Jesus was not yet glorified. ⁴⁰ When they heard these words, some in the crowd said, "This is really the prophet." ⁴¹ Others said, "This is the Messiah." But some asked, "Surely the Messiah does not come from Galilee, does he? ⁴² Has not the scripture said that the Messiah is descended from David and comes from Bethlehem, the village where David lived?" ⁴³ So <u>there was a division in the crowd</u> <u>because of him</u>. ⁴⁴ Some of them wanted to arrest him, but no one laid hands on him.
