Join us as we recognize and honor our members who are celebrating 50 or more years as members of the church.

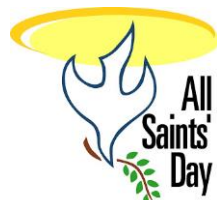


Our hope is that many from St.
